1. ELECTION OF CATHAOIRLEACH

**3. NOMINATION OF ONE REPRESENTATIVE TO IRISH BODIES
MUTUAL INSURANCES LIMITED**

It was proposed by Cllr O'Neill and seconded by Cllr Murrin that Cllr
McDonnell be representative for Irish Bodies Mutual Insurances Limited.

It was proposed by Cllr O'Neill to suspend the June monthly meeting until next month however one item needed attention Midoc for Edenderry , this was seconded by Cllr Leddin.

After much discussion with all members with regard to how best to move forward with extending Midoc to Edenderry, it was proposed by Cllr O'Neill to write to Minister Mary Harney to invite her to Edenderry to discuss the situation urgently this was seconded by Cllr Leddin. It was proposed by Cllr McDonnell and seconded by Cllr Cribbin to forward the following motion to Offaly County Council, Edenderry Area and Tullamore Town Council for their support -

“That Edenderry Town Council request the active support of Offaly County Council, Edenderry Area Committee and Tullamore Town Council in their efforts to have the H.S.E. urgently provide an out of hours GP co-operative service in Edenderry”
