On the proposal of Cllr Hogan and seconded by Cllr Breen the minutes of the Edenderry Town Council monthly April meeting 2010 were confirmed and signed.

In relation to area minutes circulated paid parking issues were a concern to members and it was proposed by Cllr McDonnell and seconded by Cllr O'Neill to organise a meeting with area members as soon as possible. Cllr Leddin raised the issue that town council should meet with the area members on a bimonthly basis. This suggestion would be brought to the area meeting through Cathaoirleach Cllr O'Neill.

Cllr Cribbin spoke out that the service present in Edenderry is saving lives and it's a shame that Edenderry will have to wait until 2012 to upgrade this service. Cllr Foley and Cllr McDonnell both agreed that there are issues that the HSE have to contend with but we have to remain hopeful that the service Edenderry needs will be delivered.

**Suspension of Standing Orders**

It was requested by Cllr McDonnell to suspend standing orders re dog warden service in the county. It was proposed by Cllr McDonnell and seconded by Cllr Cribbin to ask area manager to take a look at dog warden service and to improve it in the event of an emergency.

Cllr Hogan proposed that a letter of congratulations be sent to Mary Hanley on organisations of Fleadh Ceoil held in Edenderry this was seconded by Cllr O'Neill.

Cllr McDonnell wished Arlene Kelly well in Rose of Tralee.

It was proposed by Cllr Cribbin and seconded by Cllr O'Neill to write to the NRA re signage issues on Dublin to Galway road and on Tullamore by pass coming into Tullamore from the Birr Road.

Cllr McDonnell complimented Minister Pat Carey on legislation introduced on criminalising sale of legal highs. The Psychoactive Substances Bill will also allow gardaí to seek a court order to close head shops suspected of selling drug-like products with the onus on the owners to prove they are not involved in such activities. The head shop in Edenderry is now closed.
