CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Offaly County Council Arts Office is currently seeking proposals/quotations from Professional Film Facilitators for the delivery of a six-day programme of film workshops to schools in Offaly. The programme will consider either animated or live action.

WORKSHOPS

Please find below a few details about the workshops that may help your proposal and quotation:

Time of Year:

• Delivery in February - March 2025: exact dates are to be arranged directly with school

Schools:

- 1 Secondary School in Offaly Delivery to Transition Year Students (40 students or less)
- 2 Primary Schools in Offaly

 Delivery to 5th/6th Class
 (30 students or less per school)

Workshops

• 2 Full days in Secondary School, 2 full days per primary school each

Budget:

- Between €4000-5000 to include travel, materials, facilitation fees (This is an educational project so VAT is not applicable)
- Payment in two instalments of 50% At the start and on delivery of agreed films.

OUTCOME

- 1. Completed/edited high quality short films (less than 5min each), delivered by June 2025.
- 2. Social media quality copies of films.
- 3. The mini movies will premiere at OFFLine Film Festival in October as part of the festival programme; the attendance of the facilitator filmmaker(s) will be desirable during the premier
