1.0 Introduction

Prior to the start of the Offaly Burial Grounds project, there had never been a comprehensive survey of burial grounds in County Offaly. A survey was conducted in November 2001 by Offaly County Council which provided a figure of 107 burial grounds in the county. Out of this a total of 58 were indicated as being owned by the County Council or the Urban District Councils. 26 were marked as belonging to the Church of Ireland and a further 21 were in the ownership of the Catholic church. Finally 2 burial grounds, Dungar (OF063) and St Michael's, Portarlington (G167) came under juristiction of the Joint Burial Boards. The Joint Burial Boards were subsequently dissolved in 2013 (Goventment Publication, 2013).




Figure 1: Ownership of Burial Grounds Based on 2001 Survey

Another survey was carried out in 2006, by John Kearney and Maureen Kincaid of the Offaly Historical Society. The purpose of their survey was to check what burial ground memorials had been recorded and which had yet to be done. The list of burial grounds in the article was not comprehensive but had more detail than the 2001 survey by the County Council. The figure provided in this survey was around 132. There were some duplications of burial grounds and also burial registers were also listed. This survey along with the Offaly County Council survey proved to be an excellent start for a more indepth survey of Offaly burial grounds. Before the survey began it was estimated that there were around 200 burial grounds in the county.

1.1 Definition

The words "graveyard" and "cemetery" imply a place were people were or are buried, but for this survey the term "burial ground" was decided to be used as it encompasses the various places where people have been/are buried. The term "graveyard" typically applies to places people have been buried where is also a church, and a "cemetery" is a place people are buried where there is no church.

For the purpose of this survey the criteria a "burial ground" must meet to be included in the suvey is that it has to either be indicated on the 1838 (6 inch) or 1910 (25 inch) OSI maps or must be a place where people have been buried post 1700 A.D., however this may include sites with pre 1700 A.D. burials but where people have subsequently been buried, post 1700 A.D.

These criteria were used to eliminate antiquarian sites such as those in eskers where skeletons have been found during quarrying. These burials are certainly pre 1700. In all cases where a burial ground no longer has above surface remains, one or more pieces of evidence were required to justify it being a "burial ground". As mentioned above, the evidence could come in the form of it being present on either the 6 inch or 25 inch historic maps or a report from www.archaeology.ie.

1.2 Aims & Objective

The main aim of this project was to comprehensively list all known burial grounds in County Offaly that meet the initial criteria of what a burial ground was defined as, and also to collect information on each burial ground under the following headings:

- Name of burial ground and townland it is located in
- Location, access and parking
- Register of Monuments and Places & Register of Protected Structures numbers if applicable
- ITM (Irish Transverse Mercator) coordinates
- Ownership details
- Management details
- Site description, details of vegetation and condition and information of the boundary wall

This key information, along with other information on management and status of each burial ground along with historic maps, aerial views and up to date site photos was the key information to be collected during the duration of the project and entered into an MS Access database.

The objective was to provide this information to the general public as well as internal use for Offaly County Counil.

2.0 Methodology

This section outlines the various methods used to compile the Offaly Burial Grounds database from the intital desk based survey to undertaking indvidual site visits to each burial ground in the county.

2.1 Desk Based Research

A good proportion of the project required the use of secondary sources of information. The intial two sources used were the list of burial grounds by Offaly County Council (2001) and the list of Offaly cemeteries complied by Kearney & Kincaid (2006), both sources provided a good starting point for a more comprehensive and detailed study.

Once the previous surveys had been cross referenced, additional historic burial grounds were found by using www.archaeology.ie and the historic Ordnance Survey maps (http://maps.osi.ie/). Both sources contributed a large number of burial grounds which helped build up the number in the database. Various books in the Tullamore Central Library and Offaly Historical Society were also consulted for information. Satellite images from Bing Maps (https://www.bing.com/maps) were also consulted and aided in finding modern burial grounds.

The information from www.archaeology.ie was downloaded and saved for each historic site as reference material and copies of the 1838 and 1910 maps were also saved for use in the database, modern satellite views were saved from Bing maps.

In some cases where the name of a burial ground was not already known, the name was taken from the 1838 (6 inch map) if it named the burial ground. If not, the burial ground was given the name of the townland it is in.

2.2 Field Work

Field work was an essential part of the project, as there is no substitute for visiting a site in person. It provides the opportunity to record information first hand, to be able to take photographs and to be able to assess the condition of the burial ground and its features.

Field trips were undertaken as often as possible to visit as many of the burial grounds as possible. Many days were spent visiting various burial grounds around the county. Burial grounds were visted in clusters, for example the burial grounds around Birr were done as a lot and the same for the four burial grounds around Banagher. Once the main areas were visited, days were spent visiting individual burial grounds which were more or less isolated, this process ensured none were missed.

Field work pro-forma sheets were made for taking notes during each site visit. During site visits good photos were taken of the key features of the burial ground, such as any sign posts, the entrance, boundary walls, coffin stands, vegatation and general views.

2.3. Talks and Presentations

Being able to engage with Offaly County Councillors at Municipal District meetings and members of the general public at historical talks was an excellent way of publicising the project and letting people know of the problems associated with burial grounds. County Councillors generally welcomed the information and there was excellent feedback from historical society talks. Some of the presentations and talks generated articles in the local newspapers, the Midland Tribune and Tullamore Tribute which was good publicity for the project and informing people what it is about.

3.0 Results

The end result of the project is a list of **187** burial grounds which are located in the county. Of these 170 have been visited. The remaining sites were not visited due to the lack of any recorded surface remains and time limitations.

Some statistics are provided below which have been put together from the survey to include ownership and distribution of burial grounds thoughout the county. More detailed information on the different burial grounds is contained in the second part of this document, which is the actual burial grounds project survey.

3.1 Ownership




Figure 2. Burial Ground Ownership

Figure 2 shows the varied and somewhat complex ownership of burial grounds in County Offaly. The largest amount, or 35% of burial grounds in the county are owned by Offaly County Council. This includes burial grounds with Medieval church ruins to more recent burial grounds dating from the 20th century. The Catholic church also owns a considerable number of burial grounds too, 26% of the total. Most of these are relatively modern burial grounds from the 20th century. The Church of Ireland retain ownership over most Church of Ireland burial grounds, making up 13% of the total figure. However there are some exceptions to this such as Ballyboy (OF011), where the church and burial ground was signed over to Offaly County Council.

It was surpising to discover that 21% of burial grounds are in private ownership, this varies from somewhat substantial family burial grounds such as Aghanvilla (OF002) to sites where there are only slight remains of a former burial ground such as Killaghintober (G096), however these are only two examples of burial grounds in private hands.

There are four examples where a burial grounds are owned by either a government body, the Quakers or a coummity group. The National Monument service own the sites at Clonmacnoise (OF047) and Durrow (OF150). Ownership of burial grounds was established using the best available information at the time of the survey, which in some cases involved speaking to the landowner.

Distribution




Figure 3. Distribution of Burials Grounds

Figure 3 shows how burial grounds are distributed in County Offaly by Municipal District. Birr Municipal District has the most burial grounds, followed by Edenderry and then Tullamore. Most likely this reflects the individual sizes of the different districts.

4.0 Maintenance

Having assessed each burial ground individually, certain problems have been observed, such as the need to conserve and preserve church ruins, fix boundary walls and maintain vegetation on a regular basis. Each section below will discuss the different issues pertaing to certain burial grounds. In certain cases the problems have already been remedied.

As the problems range from small to large scale, different measures can be employed to tackle each one. The simple but very effective task of cutting grass is done by various people on different schemes such as the Rural Social Scheme, Gateway scheme and TUS. These groups have been advised as to which burial grounds require grass cutting and it is hoped that regular cutting will be maintained. For the cutting back of ivy on medieval ruins, contractors are required as they are insured to work at height. It is hoped that sites with church ruins overgrown with ivy will have the ivy cut back once every 3 to 4 years.

On the larger scale of things, ruins have been identified which need conservation work, so hopefully this important work can be undertaken in the near future.

4.1 Church Ruins

A number of burial grounds contain church ruins, some of which have been conserved and/or stabilised. However some are not in such a good state or repair and will require attention in the near future. The following sites contain church ruins which require attention:

Ballintemple OF010
Drumcullen OF062
Kilbride OF082
Kilmochonna OF106
Lynally OF115

4.2 Boundary Walls

Out of 187 sites, only 4 were identified as requiring boundary repair. This figure was initally 5, but one of the boundary walls which was breached was repaired during the course of the project. The boundary walls which are damaged are at the following sites:

Ballintemple OF010
Fancroft OF068
Lynally OF115
Kilcolman OF087

It is hoped that as funds become available in the near future that the sections of wall at these sites will be repaired.

4.3 Vegetation

Without regular cutting back of grass or ivy, it is easy for a site to become overgrown. 18 sites in the county have been identified as requiring ivy being cut back on church ruins. It is hoped that now these sites have been identified that the ivy will be cut back at least once every 3 to 4 years. It is planned that grass will be cut back on a more regular basis, around 2 times a year. The sites which require ivy trimming are as follows:

5.0 Discussion and Conclusions

This survey represents a body of work comprehensively done for the first time. It is hoped that the information will prove useful to a variety of people. It is important to note that the information collected for the survey was the best available at the time. Ownership of the different burial grounds is not a definitive guide and it is possible that this is subject to change in years to come.

The decision was taken to give each burial ground a simple unique reference number, which so far appears to be effective. This eliminates the problem of multiple burial grounds with the same or similar names, such as Kilbride, Ballyintemple and Ballynakill of which there is more than one of each.

The results of this survey give for the first time a good view of the ownership structure burial of grounds in the county and of the maintenance issues. With information in hand the associated problems with burial grounds such as over grown vegetation can be tackled. Upon completion of this survey in late March 2015, ivy had already been cut back in several burial grounds (Ballymacwilliam (OF017), Kilmurryely (OF107), Lynally (OF115) and Kilmanaghan (OF105).
