#### 2. Housing Report

Ms. M. Cleary, S.E.O., presented the Housing Report, as circulated, to the members. She advised that a proposed programme of works for estate management would be presented to the members for their agreement at a later meeting. She also advised that a HAP Place Finder had been appointed on a shared basis between Offaly and Laois County Councils. The members welcomed the Report, raising a number of issues incl.: expected timeline for Raheen housing development; possibility of the Council applying for Dept. funding for inner relief road at Raheen in conjunction with the housing development; update on Repair & Lease Scheme; housing list status of HAP tenants; HAP housing standards enforcement; suitability of housing acquisitions for people with disabilities; illegal dumping at Pearse Park back lane; waste management requirements for council tenants. A discussion also ensued regarding the possibility of Offaly County Council acquiring Marian Hostel for accommodation use. Ms. M. Cleary responded to, and agreed to follow up on all queries raised.

Ms. M. Cleary then left the meeting.

#### 3. Update on Tullamore Street Enhancement Programme

Mr. T. Shanahan, D.O.S., updated the members on Tullamore Street Enhancement Programme. The works were at an early stage, no major problems to date. The members welcomed the report raising a number of issues: possibility of monthly progress reports being issued to the

public, social media; signage issues; car parking issues. It was agreed that the members would be kept updated on all issues.
