1. Confirmation of Minutes

Minutes of Monthly Meeting held on 10th December 2020 were approved on the proposal of Cllr. D. Harvey and seconded by Cllr. T. McCormack.

2. Roads Report

Mr. John Connelly presented the report as circulated to the members. The members welcomed the report raising a number of queries including; flooding at Charleville Rd; gritting; providing grit to private housing estates; footpath cleaning; modify the footpath at the Green, Clara to allow vehicular access; extending the footpath to the recently purchased Priests house in Clara; data from Speed counter in Blueball; footpath from Heather Grove, Clara; traffic calming and footpaths in Adams Villas; footpath on Church Rd; reduced outdoor staff in the Clara area.

In response Mr. J Connelly outlined flooding in Charleville View is under review; increasing salting routes would be referred to Roads, TMD will continue to respond to local issues outside of the main routes; providing grit may have insurance implications; a sweeping machine and power washer has been purchased for cleaning the paths; vehicular dishing will be carried out on the path at The Green; a temporary solution to the footpath at Heather Grove will be investigated; reduced manpower due to illness has effected in the manpower available, recruitment process underway.

3. Public Lighting Report

Mr. John Connelly presented the Public Lighting Report, as circulated, to the members. Mr. Connelly to draft a list for Public Lighting Scheme 2021 incorporating funding streams to maximise leverage and benefit.

4. Regeneration Projects

Mr. John Connelly updated the members on regeneration projects to date. The members expressed disappointment following the 2020 TVR announcement and the unsuccessful applications for Ballycumber and Killeigh. In addition the members request a letter be issued to the Dept requesting Ballycumber and Killeigh be added as an adhoc project. Mr. T. Shanahan advised as a standard procedure OCC would request feedback from the Dept and noted there was no issue with the quality of the application stating OCC received the second highest allocation in the Country.
