5. Draft Budgetary Plan 2022 - Consideration of the amount of General Municipal Allocation

Mr. T. Shanahan, DOS presented the Municipal District Allocation for Tullamore, as circulated to the members. Mr. T. Shanahan updated the members and advised the Chief Executive was proposing a General Municipal Allocation of €177,000, allocation for Tullamore MD in the Draft Budget 2023 to be considered at OCC's Statutory Budgetary Meeting. It was noted that the GMA fund achieves significant projects and further funding would be sought at the council budget meeting.
