2. Housing Report

Mr. John Cunningham, Senior Engineer, Housing Department presented the report as circulated to the members. The members welcomed the report, raising a number of issues incl.: timeline for Raheen and Sycamore Drive, Ballycumber; funding for vacant property in Twickenham; discretion around €30k limit on DPG; turnaround time for vacant houses; waiting list for DPGs and HAG; prioritise retrofit scheme; purchase of one off houses; Housing Needs Assessment. Mr. John Cunningham responded to queries raised noting Raheen retendered is due to price increase; Twickenham will be funded under Buy and Renew Scheme; no discretion on DPG

scheme; specialist contractors required for Retrofit scheme; not a actively purchasing one off houses; failure to reply to Housing Needs assessment will result in removal from the list.

The members requested correspondence be issued to the Minister regarding increasing the threshold under the Housing Assistance Payment.

3. Regeneration

Mr. John Connelly, District Engineer presented the report as circulated to the members noting there are eight projects currently under construction with a further 6 in final design or tender stage with additional schemes under Active Travel.

The members welcomed the report, raising a number of queries incl.: timeline for remaining TVR scheme in Ballycumber, Badgers Lane, ESB Mountbolus; Pedestrian crossing at Dolans; issues at Pedestrian Crossing at Collins Lane;

Mr. J. Connelly outlined Badgers Lane is gone to tender; Ballycumber by year end; Pedestrian crossing at Dolans will be included; traffic management is under constant review at Collins Lane, civil works close to completion.

The members complimented the efficiency of local contractors working on the 2022 Roads Programme.

4. Upcoming Events

Ms. B. Corbet confirmed following the success of the 2021 inaugural Halloween event Puca Spooka is confirmed for 22nd and 23rd October.

Tullamore Municipal District is again working with Up Close and Personal Promotions and are inviting all of Offaly and surrounding areas to come along and take part in Halloween festivities, which is suitable for all the family. The event is buggy, wheelchair and sensory friendly event. Parking will available in various public car parks throughout the town, which will provide the opportunity for those attending the event to support the local business in town. This will again be a free event, however this year it will be strictly ticketed. In order to facilitate set up for Púca Spooka, the play equipment of Lloyd Town Park will be closed and pedestrian access limited from Wednesday 19th October until Monday 24th October.

An event will take place in Millennium Sq. on Friday 30th September from 2pm to 6pm to mark Tullamore 400 with an outdoor art exhibition showcasing a selection of images of Tullamore. All are welcome to attend and look back at key highlights of the town over the past 400 years. Tullamore Municipal District are working in association with Offaly History and Up Close and Personal Promotions.
