BIRR WRITERS RESIDENCY



Applications are now being sought for the 2023 Birr Writers' Residency.

This residency offers professional writers accommodation and workspaces for six nights, at Brendan House in the centre of Birr, County Offaly. This Georgian Heritage Town in the midlands of Ireland has a remarkable history, and is embedded in a community with a thriving arts culture.

The purpose of the residency is to provide an opportunity for artists to focus on a writing project (current or new) in a tranquil environment which supports and values high professional artistic development. It is open to professional writers of any genre, e.g. literary fiction, poetry, playwrights, journalism or travel writing. Brendan House is a period home and occasional guest house, located in the heart of the heritage town of Birr. The adjoining working arts studio, Tin Jug Studio opened as County Offaly's first art gallery in 2000. Although largely private, it has ever since then been opened for artists gatherings; childrens' art classes; art, educational and environment workshops and talks; poetry and music performances; festival art exhibitions; book and other community launches; and film screenings. Each year since 2014, the Offaly Arts Office -funded award offers up to four writers, one week (7 days and 6 nights) bed and breakfast accommodation in one of the period rooms of the guest area.
