- Approval must be given by the Council prior to the commencement of any works to erect or place a headstone, kerbing, tablet, etc on any plot in a Council cemetery.
- The height of any headstone may not exceed 1.2 metres above beam level. Special permission may be given for Celtic cross headstones up to 2.1m high in traditional cemeteries where similar headstones have already been permitted.
- ❖ All Plot fees due to the Council must be paid before returning application.
- Signed permission to erect memorial must be produced to Caretaker/Registrar before commencement of works.
- Completed application forms should be returned to the address above
