

# Oifig na gCoimisinéirí Teanga / Office of the Language Commissioners

## **Oifig na gCoimisinéirí Teanga**

Leanann Comhairle Contae Uíbh Fhailí ag plé le hOifig an Choimisinéara Teanga maidir le gearáin a ardaítear agus comhlíonadh Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla 2003 agus Acht na dTeangacha Oifigiúla (Leasú) 2021, lena n-áirítear oibriú i dtreo riachtanas fógraíochta (20% de na fógraí a chur go dátheangach nó i nGaeilge amháin agus 5% den chaiteachas ar fhógraíocht sna Meáin Ghaeilge).

### **I 2023:**

Fuair an Chomhairle trí ghearán ó Oifig an Choimisinéara Teanga maidir le comharthaíocht neamhghearán agus fógraí béil ar sheirbhís oíche gutháin na Comhairle. Réitíodh na trí cinn in 2023 agus comhlíonadh cuid den chomharthaíocht i ngearán amháin in 2023 agus bhí an chuid eile sceidealaithe le comhlíonadh in 2024.

## **Office of the Language Commissioners**

Offaly County Council continues to engage with the Office of the Language Commissioners (Oifig an Choimisinéara Teanga) on complaints raised and compliance with the Official Languages Act 2003 and the Official Languages (Amendment) Act 2021, including working towards advertising requirements (20% of ads to be placed bilingually or in Irish only and 5% of advertising spend in Irish Language Media).

### **In 2023:**

Three complaints were received by the Council from Oifig na gCoimisinéirí Teanga relating to non-complaint signage and oral announcements on the Council's phone night service. All three were resolved in 2023 with some of the signage in one complaint being brought into compliance in 2023 and the remainder scheduled to be brought into compliance in 2024.
