

Pollagh/Lemanaghan village plan Services and facilities, p 39 - it says 'community shop and youth space' but these 2 services are no longer combined. The youth space has moved to the community centre - There is no other shop other than the community shop - There is no soccer pitch SO3 - Could this be more specific or targeted? eg list desired facilities such as a public toilet, or continued support for the community shop S04 - This is a very important overall objective - Specifically mention Turraun Wetlands (as we see this site as of crucial heritage importance to the village) - Could Pollagh be promoted as a watersports (canoeing, kayaking, angling etc) destination on the canal and river Brosna, which would require some infrastructure such as changing rooms, and also restocking of the river and canal with fish - Promotion of Pollagh as a canalside village as in the Waterways Corridor Study, as an ideal stopping point for boats travelling on the canal SO5 - This is a very worthwhile objective. - Also we would support creation of a cycling/walking route to school from Lemanaghan SO7 - Can this be more specific in terms of what/how it will be achieved, for instance education, hedgerow management, awareness. - Inclusion of Turraun in any biodiversity strategy/plans/consultations. This site has not been made full use of or maintained in a way that would facilitate biodiversity engagement, recreation or education In addition: - Improve the appearance of Plunkett Bridge, possibly by the upgrade of bridge barrier - Better management/awareness of flood risk - Longer term possibility of developing a river walk along the Brosna and public green space in the village core
