CO.OFFALY DRAFT DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2021-2027 (SUBMISSION) Amendment to Record of Protected Structures Item 23-221 (Regional) War Memorial, O'Connor Square, Tullamore The description of the above protected structure is incorrect and the appraisal is not sufficiently comprehensive. The following wording would be more appropriate: Description The Memorial was erected in 1926 (not 1950 as the entry states) and was designed by the architect E.W. Doyle Jones and executed in local Ballyduff limestone. It consists of an obelisk on a plinth standing on two steps and surrounded by a raised kerb which creates a space for wreaths and commemorative offerings. It bears the inscription 'Erected to the glorious memory of the men of Offaly (Kings County) who gave their lives in the Great War 1914-1919'. Appraisal The Memorial which was erected by a committee of local people led by the Town Council and with the participation of the British Legion, stands in the axial centre of O'Connor Square, the principal public space of the town.
