

Killurin Sráid Plan

Settlement Description

Settlement Context: Killurin is located on the R421, 7km southwest of Tullamore. The settlement is pre-dominantly linear in nature, with the Killurin GAA facilities having created a centre point around which the settlement has developed.

Services and Facilities: GAA pitch.

Waste Water Treatment: Individual effluent treatment systems.

Water Supply: Private Group Water Scheme.

Broadband: High speed broadband is available.



Settlement Objectives

General Objectives

Infrastructure and Public Realm

- GO1 A planting scheme should be devised for the village to ensure that the existing mature trees, which greatly add to the village setting, are being replenished over time.
- GO2 Improvement of the existing road network, public lighting and footpaths.
- GO3 New Gateway features which could contribute to traffic calming on the approach roads.
- GO4 Groundwater source protection zone must be protected.

Development and Design

- GO5 The conservation and integration into new development of existing trees and native hedgerows.
- GO6 Killurin shall be developed in a properly planned and coherent manner, with the GAA facilities remaining as the focal point.
- GO7 Development shall be directed so as to have a minimal impact on the Area of High Amenity (Esker) and only appropriately designed and sensitive development shall be considered.

Specific Objectives (refer to map)

- SO1 Formalisation of car parking and public realm enhancement works at the GAA grounds.
