- Cllr F. Moran queried if there would be a further public consultation on the Clara Town Centre First plan and Ms J Ryan confirmed there would.
- Cllr T. McCormack enquired about road marking in the town and Mr J Connelly confirm it was ongoing;
- Cllr. D Harvey referred to the footpath on Charleville Road, new lights in various locations in the town and the cleaning of gullies; Mr J Connelly confirm jetting of gullies was an ongoing general maintenance activity;
- Cllr D Owens acknowledged the progress of the Mucklagh TVR;



Cllr K. Smollen requested that the flooding at Boland's Terrace, Clara be investigated and the lights in the Daingean carpark fixed; Mr J Connelly confirmed that the flooding was being investigated and the lights were installed in the Daingean carpark, awaiting commissioning;

Cllr S. O'Brien enquired about the public lights in Church Street to be finalized and noted the pedestrian crossing on the Arden road is damaged;

Cllr N. Feighery acknowledged the good work ongoing including Mountbolus TVR;

A number of Cllrs acknowledged the good work carried out and referred to the delay traffic light and beacons to finalizing some projects;
